Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Trinity! This feast has a special meaning for me personally as it was the feast we celebrated on the first Sunday I was in the parish after being ordained and assigned a parochial vicar at St. John Vianney. I remember being a young priest thinking what a complex feast to be the first time people heard me preach!). The origins of the celebration of Trinity Sunday go all the way back to the Arian heresy of the fourth century. Arius believed that Christ was a created being, and, in denying the divinity of Christ, he denied that there are three Persons in God. Arius' chief opponent, Athanasius, upheld the orthodox doctrine that there are three Persons in one God, and the orthodox view prevailed at the Council of Nicaea, from which we get the Nicene Creed, recited in most Catholic churches every Sunday. The celebration of Trinity Sunday was made universal by Pope John XXII (1316-1334).



This Wednesday we will graduate 63 eighth graders from our school. I could not be happier for them. They are a great group of young people. Recently they were at recess and a woman was on a bench near the playground crying and very distraught. They called me out, and we were able to get her help. But what impressed me the most was when Mrs. Garuckas, their religion teacher, told me that afternoon they all wanted to lift that woman up in prayer. This is just who this class is as a group. They are very diverse but all seem to have a wonderful compassionate care for all people. Fr. Scott and I got them a book for their graduation entitled *Don't Sweat the Small Stuff for Teens*. To accompany the book, we wrote a letter quoting our late Pontiff and Saint, John Paul II when he said, "I believe in the youth with all my strength and conviction." We could not say it better. We believe that our world is in very capable hands and our future is very bright because of the amazing talents and gifts they bring to it now and will continue to bring to it in the future. Please lift them up in your prayers as they make this important journey of transition in life.

This coming week is also the last day of school (Friday, May 27). This has been a great school year. I am very proud of the faculty, staff, parents/guardians, and students. I believe this was a very productive year of growing in life, love, and learning. Under the capable and strong leadership of Ms. Cosgriff and Mrs. Dodd our children have grown in knowledge of their faith and academics. We are in full gear for planning next school year. 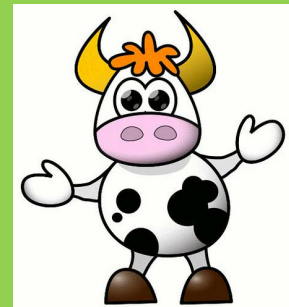
