Hello PSR Families:

Per the Diocese of Cleveland, PSR programs are expected to follow the COVID-19 safety measures put in place by the parish/school community under which they function. Therefore, the Ss. Robert & William / Saint John of the Cross PSR program will follow the practices and procedures of the Ss. Robert & William day school.

At the end of last week, the school made the decision to heed the recommendation of the Cuyahoga County Board of Health, and they adjusted to remote learning for the first month of the 2020-2021 school year. Our PSR program will follow suit.

What does this mean?

- PSR will still move forward as planned, utilizing the calendar that is set in place.
- Families who have chosen the **traditional classroom setting** will begin the year by using the *Christ In Us* web portal. *Christ In Us* is able to accommodate the change to distance learning. When students move back to the traditional classroom, their teachers will pick up where parents/guardians have left off. We hope to transition back to the SRW school building on Sunday, October 3.
- Families who have chosen to utilize the ***Christ In Us* web portal** will remain unchanged.
- **Homeschooling** will remain unchanged.

If you have not yet registered, please still do! When asked to indicate your preferred learning model, still indicate your top preference. Registrations will be accepted through Monday, August 24.

Textbooks will be ready for pick up in the SRW parish office during the week of September 7. Also during this week, the welcome video and *Christ In Us* web portal tutorial will be accessible. You will need to view both of these, with your child(ren), prior to beginning the program on September 13.
