**January 17, 2021 – 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time**

### **Call - Waiting**

Today's readings talk to us about a "call" – Samuel called by the Lord, and the first disciples called by Jesus. Our God constantly calls us to enter into a personal relationship. In daily life, especially during these difficult Covid Pandemic days, it is not so simple to hear the call of God. Sometimes others are most valuable in helping us: Eli helped Samuel, and Andrew helped his brother Simon. We invite you to Come and See how the Catholic Community can help you to respond to emptiness, or a longing to get to know God better, or a sense of being drawn to the Catholic Church. We call this invitation an Inquiry session.
