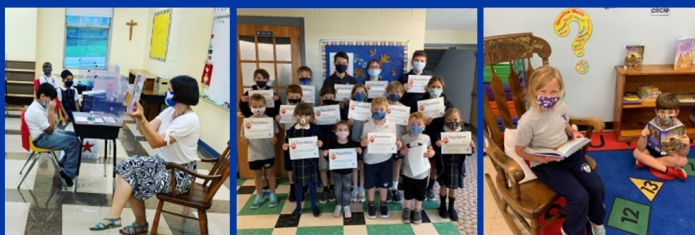

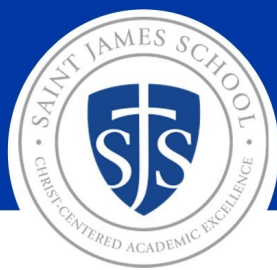

### Decision Making

Making decisions is not always easy. Sometimes we have second thoughts about what we are doing. Sometimes we hesitate or waver. Sometimes we need to affirm a choice we have already made. So it is with God's call to come closer to him. Maybe we are eager to respond but afraid there will be a price to be paid. Perhaps we may just want to maintain the status quo because we are unwilling to invest the energy and time that it would require. Do you or someone you know hear God calling to come closer? Typically, the call from God is indicated in the desires and hopes of our hearts. To help, we offer RCIA Inquiry Sessions to gather, ask, learn, pray, ponder and discern.

Inquiry sessions are held so that those who wish to ask questions about the Catholic faith family can do so in an informed, non-pressured atmosphere. We invite anyone who is not baptized, baptized into another faith denomination, or baptized Catholic but has not received Eucharist and Confirmation. Inquiry sessions are for those who wish to inquire, explore, and search for ways to grow in relationship with God. Have a question for yourself or a family member? Make the call!
