

Nativity teachers and staff are thrilled to welcome students back to school in our building on August 10th! A few families have contacted Ms. Bianchini to share that due to health and/or family matters, they want to stay a part of the Nativity School community but would like to continue eLearning as we begin the 2020-2021 school year. After much discussion and consultation, we have determined that continuing eLearning is a possible alternative for families. After reviewing the parent and teacher survey results from last year's eLearning period, we have made a few adjustments to the program.

We envision that our 2020-2021 eLearning Program will include:

- A video of the classroom teacher's direct instruction lesson in Language Arts and Math class will be made available to students electronically. Videos of other subject areas may be available but at this time cannot be promised. We have hired a part-time person to do the videotaping and the availability of other subject area videos will depend on scheduling.
- For our elementary students, classwork and homework for all subject areas will be sent via email and/or will be available for pick up at school on Fridays. Completed work will be due the following Friday. For students in the upper grades, assignments that are sent home electronically will be due on the same date as their "in-school" classmates. Assignments that can't be sent electronically will be available for pick up on Fridays and will be due the following Friday.
- All assignments will be graded on the school grading scale which can be found in the Family Handbook.
- Appointments will be made for the student to take tests and quizzes at school at a time/room with no contact with other students.
