Our Lady of Altigracia

The brother Antonio and Alonso Trejo were the ones who established the devotion to the Virgin Mary on the island called Hispaniola by the colonizers. Already in the 15th century, she was revered in the present-day Dominican Republic where, according to tradition, she had appeared to a peasant, who called her Mary of the Higher Grace, who brings the Savior into the world. Numerous stories are told about the favors and miracles of Our Lady on the Island. Among these stands out that of a girl from Higüey who asked her father for a painting of the Virgin of Altigracia. The father tried unsuccessfully to get one everywhere, but no one had heard of that advocacy. When he was about to give up, an elderly man with a long beard took out a small, rolled up canvas with the image of the Virgin from his saddlebag and handed it to the man saying: "This is what you are looking for." Shortly after the old man disappeared, wrapped in mystery, and the devotion began to spread everywhere. The original basilica of Our Lady of Altigracia, located in the city of Salvaleón de Higüey, is considered the oldest Marian sanctuary in America.



Saint Francis de Sales' Story

Francis was destined by his father to be a lawyer so that the young man could eventually take his elder's place as a senator from the province of Savoy in France. For this reason Francis was sent to Padua to study law. After receiving his doctorate, he returned home and, in due time, told his parents he wished to enter the priesthood. His father strongly opposed Francis in this, and only after much patient persuasiveness on the part of the gentle Francis did his father finally consent. Francis was ordained and elected provost of the Diocese of Geneva, then a center for the Calvinists. Francis set out to convert them, especially in the district of Chablais. By preaching and distributing the little pamphlets he wrote to explain true Catholic doctrine, he had remarkable success. At 35, he became bishop of Geneva. While administering his diocese he continued to preach, hear confessions, and catechize the children. His gentle character was a great asset in winning souls. He practiced his own axiom, "A spoonful of honey attracts more flies than a barrelful of vinegar." Besides his two well-known books, the *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *A Treatise on the Love of God*, he wrote many pamphlets and carried on a vast correspondence. For his writings, he has been named patron of the Catholic Press. His writings, filled with his characteristic gentle spirit, are addressed to lay people. He wants to make them understand that they too are called to be saints. As he wrote in *The Introduction to the Devout Life*: "It is an error, or rather a heresy, to say devotion is incompatible with the life of a soldier, a tradesman, a prince, or a married woman.... It has happened that many have lost perfection in the desert that had preserved it in the world." In spite of his busy and comparatively short life, he had time to collaborate with another saint, Jane Frances de Chantal, in the work of establishing the Sisters of the Visitation. These women were to practice the virtues exemplified in Mary's visit to Elizabeth: humility, piety, and mutual charity. They at first engaged to a limited degree in works of mercy for the poor and the sick. Today, while some communities conduct schools, others live a strictly contemplative life.



Nuestra Señora de la Altigracia

El hermano Antonio y Alonso Trejo fueron los que establecieron la devoción a la Virgen María en la isla llamada La Española por los colonizadores. Ya en el siglo XV, fue venerada en la República Dominicana actual, donde, según la tradición, se le había aparecido a una campesina, que la llamó María de la Alta Gracia, que trae al Salvador al mundo. Se cuentan numerosas historias sobre los favores y milagros de Nuestra Señora en la Isla. Entre estos destaca el de una niña de Higüey que le pidió a su padre una pintura de la Virgen de la Altigracia. El padre intentó sin éxito conseguir uno en todas partes, pero nadie había oído hablar de esa invocación. Cuando estaba a punto de darse por vencido, un anciano con una larga barba sacó un pequeño lienzo enrollado con la imagen de la Virgen de su alforja y se lo entregó al hombre diciendo: "Esto es lo que estás buscando". Poco después el viejo desapareció, envuelto en el misterio, y la devoción comenzó a extenderse por todas partes. La basílica original de Nuestra Señora de la Altigracia, ubicada en la ciudad de Salvaleón de Higüey, es considerada el santuario de María más antiguo de América.
