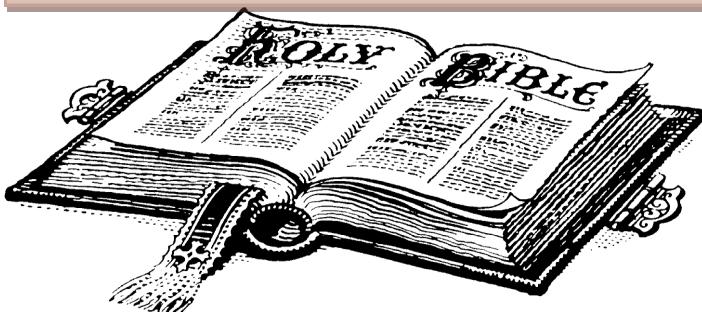

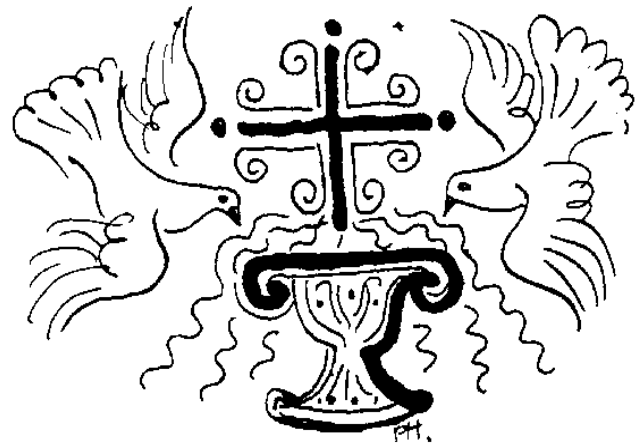

Visit to the Seven Monuments

On Holy Thursday, after the mass of the Lord's Supper has ended, the Blessed Sacrament is placed or reserved in a special place for communion on Good Friday—the day on which the Passion and death of Jesus is commemorated and Mass is not celebrated. This place, carefully prepared, is called a monument and becomes the site of pilgrimages on Holy Thursday (and on Good Friday until 3:00 p.m.). The tradition of visiting seven churches to place you in an attitude of contemplation and prayer before the monument is certainly a biblical and Catholic devotion, which is deeply rooted in the Hispanic community. The tradition has its origin in the first Jubilee or Christian Holy Year, which was convened by Pope Boniface VIII, in 1300. This Jubilee Year granted extraordinary indulgence to pilgrims who were in a state of penance after Confession and absolution, and that visited the basilicas of St. Peter and St. Paul Outside the Walls. The practice of going to seven places of prayers was introduced by St. Philip Neri in the 16th century, who began promoting and organizing visits to seven historic churches in Rome. This became a popular devotion that spread around the world and still practiced today. The visit to the seven churches is presently a reminder of that following biblical stations of the cross that Jesus endured during the final hours before his crucifixion: (1) from the Cenacle or the Upper Room to the garden of Gethsemane; (2) from the garden to the house of Annas; (3) from there to the high priest Caiaphas; (4) from Caiaphas to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate; (5) from Pilate to the palace of King Herod; (6) then again to Pilate; and (7) from Pilate to Calvary carrying the cross. The visits to the seven monuments are, therefore, a way of accompanying the Lord in his sacrifice for us and should be done in an attitude of contemplation. On the way to each church, or upon arrival, we can thank Jesus for the gift of the Eucharist and priesthood he instituted on that holy night; as well as reflect on the respective transfer of Our Lord, the sufferings endured at the time, and the affronts received. Once we were before the monument, in the presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, we must ask for mercy by way of his painful Passion and death—which we caused and were redeemed by it—and offer apologies for the neglect in which we leave him in the Tabernacle today. The prayers said during the visits to the monuments vary, although it is common to pray several of the Lord's Prayer, Hail Mary, and Glory Be. In any case, you can begin with the ejaculatory prayer. "Praised and exalted be in this monument, the Most Blessed and Divine Sacrament!"; followed by the prayer: "O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament have left us a memorial of Your Passion, grant us, we pray, so to revere the sacred mysteries of Your Body and Blood that we may always experience in ourselves the fruits of Your redemption. Through the same Jesus Christ, Our Lord. Amen."
