**Do you believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? Do you realize what an amazing gift the Eucharist is?**

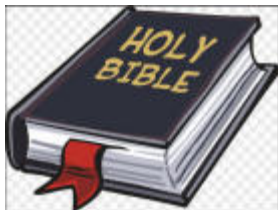
**Do you know that the Eucharist is the very heart of our Catholic faith?**
