Masks will be required at all times (with the exceptions for small children, at the judgement of their parents, and of those for whom health reasons preclude them from wearing them), except when you are about to receive the Eucharist. In order to avoid having parishioners cross through the pews in the middle of the Mass & have to remove their masks to consume the Eucharist, Fr. Rich will consecrate the Host as he normally would, but you would not receive the Eucharist until you are departing Mass at the end. He will be at the back of the church behind a plexiglass partition (for your safety as well as his), and he will be able to give you the Eucharist at that time in the hand.

We have limited seating available at Mass for the time being in order to insure the 6-foot social distancing. Because of COVID-19 and the Mass limitations, there is still a dispensation for all Catholics from your obligation to attend Mass. **Mass reservations** are required at this time so that we can accommodate as many people as possible at each Mass. We are limited to approximately 40 people at the church and about 55 at the Parish Center. By doing reservations, we can insure that we will have a seat for everyone attending the Mass. Additionally, the state does require us to get the name and phone # of anyone attending Mass should they need to trace a case of COVID-19.

Century Club registrations are now being accepted for the 2020-2021 year. The fee is \$100 to join and can be paid in full, or monthly over 10 months. This is one of our “quiet” fundraisers that has helped us many times in the past. We were able to buy all new vestments 4 years ago with Century Club funds. 2 years ago, we were able to renew our FORMED membership thanks to the club. We average about 90-100 people per year, but would LOVE to have more! Each month, there is a drawing of 7 winners for \$25 each and then at the end, we have a raffle of \$2,600 in cash prizes! If you register by December 6th and pay in full, you’ll be entered into a one time drawing of \$100 taking place on 12/7. Usually at the end of the season we have a dinner/dance at no additional cost to our members. Unfortunately, due to COVID, that couldn’t happen, but we did enjoy a wonderful to-go meal from Stoneforge instead. Please consider joining us if you haven’t already! Applications can be found online, or by calling Tracey in the office.

Bishop da Cunha and the Diocese of Fall River recently released a State of the Diocese of Fall River Report, 2014-2019. The intent of the publication is to provide parishioners, benefactors, volunteers and employees with a better understanding of how their support enables the mission of the Catholic Church in Southeastern Massachusetts, Cape Cod, and the Islands. We hope you find it helpful and informative.

Adoration has moved INSIDE at the Parish Center. Due to the limited space in the chapel (only allowing 1-2 people at a time inside under social distancing guidelines), we have Adoration set up in classrooms 1 & 2 (which have been transformed into a chapel) Adorers will enter by the door at the front left of the building & you will be able to access the door for the temporary chapel from there. For now, the times will still be M-F from 11am-8pm and then First Saturday Adoration will be 10am-3pm. Masks are required and there will be limits on the number of Adorers that can be in there at one time. We ask that you help us by sanitizing your chair/kneeler before you leave with the wipes/disinfectant provided. Thank you! If there are more than 4 people (or if you arrive early), you can also see the Blessed Sacrament from the windows outside.

The Taunton Area Community Table Meal Center (TacT), located at 378 Bay Street, has remained open during the pandemic. The model and hours have changed to follow the regulations imposed by the state to keep everyone safe. TacT is open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 11:15 AM to 12:30 PM for Grab and Go meals. Each guest is given two meals each day, a main meal with salad and dessert and a lighter fare along with snacks, fruit and other items to supplement the meals. Meals are distributed from the side door. We remain no questions asked and all are welcome. With the cooler weather, there will be a food pantry box available on the side steps at the meal center, Friday through Sunday, with non perishable food items for those who may need something extra for the weekend. On the last Thursday of the month TacT is distributing a box of non perishable groceries during our regular hours of operation. No one should be hungry. We are all in this together after all. Please stay safe, healthy and calm.

Confessions are available! Fr. Rich is out in the parking lot during designated times to hear Confessions (if it is raining or hailing, he will be on the rectory porch – and if you approach from the driveway, he won't turn around, so that you can have anonymity). In the parking lot, if you don't want him to know you, simply drive up behind him and you can stay in your car if you'd like (or you can walk up behind him. He won't turn around). If you prefer, you can bring a chair and have a face to face confession, or you can also take a walk around the parking lot with him. This week the hours will be:

TEMPORARY ADDITIONAL MASS: Due to the way in which several of the Masses fill up quickly online, we are temporarily adding another weekend Mass so as to better accommodate those wishing to attend Mass. We tried a 6pm on Sunday, but it hasn't had a ton of people & with the shortening days in November, we will see how a **3 pm Sunday Mass at the church** works instead for the "overflow." We will continue with the other additional Mass (Saturday 7 pm at the parish center) and the other "regular" Masses (Saturday 4 pm, Sunday 7:30am, 10:30 at the church; Sunday 9 am at the parish center).

Due to COVID, we aren't able to have our annual "Mass of Remembrance" as space is limited at the Church/Parish Center, restricting us to the number who would be able to attend. Instead, we've dedicated a Mass during the months of November and December to every person who had a funeral Mass celebrated here in the past year. Please continue to keep them in your prayers.

Throughout the month of November, we will pray for the souls of people whose names will be listed on the pile of All Souls envelopes. We will have a batch at each altar (church and parish center), but we will pray for all of them at both locales. You may also call/email Tracey so that she may add any names to the list.

Tuesday (December 8th) is a Holy Day- the Feast Day of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Ordinarily, it is an obligatory Mass, but due to the continued dispensation from our Bishop because of the pandemic, it's not required you attend, just like our Sunday obligation. Masses will be offered on Monday, Dec. 7th at 5:30pm for the vigil at the parish center, and then at 8am and Noon at the church and 7:30pm at the parish center on Tuesday, Dec. 8th for those wishing to attend. Please be sure to register online on our reservation portal accessed through our website. Thank you!

We are in our first weekend of Advent. Just as Lent was a little different this year, Advent will have its own unique challenges. This year, it would be the perfect opportunity for you/and your family to really use this time to take up some new traditions with Advent. Perhaps you can get/make an Advent wreath if you don't already have one. You can make a point each day to do some reflection and prayer. Perhaps take the opportunity to go to reconciliation during Advent. Find ways that you can help others, even though volunteer opportunities are not easy right now. You could call a homebound person to check on them or offer a donation to purchase food to a food pantry for example. May God bless you and your family through the Advent season.
