As we begin returning to normal, we would just like to just go over a few things. First, despite things opening back up, the obligation to attend Mass has not yet been reinstated by the Bishop. If you are still concerned for your health about returning to Mass, you can still watch from home on our Facebook page.

There will no longer be a need to register for Mass. Our capacity will be back to 100%. There will be no pews closed off and all the doors of the church will be unlocked. This is wonderful! We will also not need to sanitize the church after every Mass. We are so grateful to all those who have given their time in making sure everything was safe for everyone. Your help has been so incredibly appreciated!

We will continue offering the weeknight Masses, 7:00 PM Saturday Mass, and 9:00 AM Sunday Mass at the Parish Center. On **June 14th**, we will transition the weeknight Masses over to the church and then on the weekend of **June 19th/20th**, our weekend Masses currently held at the parish center, will move over to the church.

While masks are no longer required, we do ask that those who have not been vaccinated continue wearing masks. We have no way of telling who has been vaccinated or not so we will go on the “honor system”. No one will be asking to see any vaccination cards or asking if you’ve been vaccinated.

Hand sanitizing dispensers will continue to be offered at both the church and parish center, and all are encouraged to use them.

We are going to hold off on bringing up the gifts for a little longer and we will ask that those who are not in the same household only exchange the sign of peace by a gesture rather than a handshake. For the time being, we will not be using the offertory baskets with the handles since we have not had an opportunity to organize collection ushers at this time. The collection bins will still be located at each of the church doors for you to leave your contribution or you can utilize online giving found on our website. We have certainly felt the “pinch” during this past year. We are so grateful to all who have been able to continue giving and in many cases, giving more. We hope that as more people return to Mass, we will find it a bit easier to cover our ordinary expenses.

Finally, and this is perhaps most important, if you are not feeling well or someone in your family is not feeling well, please remain home. There is never an obligation to attend Mass when one is ill or caring for a sick family member. But again, keep in mind, the obligation to attend Mass has not been reinstated at this time. Thank you all once again for your support and understanding as we transition back to “normal.”

Bishop da Cunha and regional bishops to lift the Sunday and Holy Day Mass dispensation

Bishop Edgar M. da Cunha, S.D.V., and regional Catholic bishops have together decided to inform the Catholic faithful that the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligation will be lifted on Father’s Day, June 19-20.

The bishops saw Father’s Day weekend as an appropriate time to encourage Catholic faithful, especially families, to return to the Sunday celebration of the Eucharist, the center of every Catholic life.

The obligation does not apply to those who are ill, recently exposed to COVID-19 or other communicable illnesses, those confined to their homes or other facilities for various reasons, and those who are not able to be vaccinated for specific reasons.
