Catholic Youth Day - Aug 14

With the lifting of restrictions, the Aug 14 Mass and 4th Watch with Bishop will be expanded to be the Catholic Youth Day on Martha's Vineyard. Please save the date (Aug 14) for young people from your parish to attend with Bishop da Cunha. Updated registration information will be shared soon.

- Sunday, June 20 from 2:15 to 2:45 pm
- Saturday, June 26 from 5 to 6 pm (this time is different from the usual 3 pm time, due to a meeting Father Rich has to attend earlier)

Bishop da Cunha and regional bishops to lift the Sunday and Holy Day Mass dispensation

Bishop Edgar M. da Cunha, S.D.V., and regional Catholic bishops have together decided to inform the Catholic faithful that the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Day Mass obligation will be lifted on Father's Day, June 19-20.

The bishops saw Father's Day weekend as an appropriate time to encourage Catholic faithful, especially families, to return to the Sunday celebration of the Eucharist, the center of every Catholic life.

The obligation does not apply to those who are ill, recently exposed to COVID-19 or other communicable illnesses, those confined to their homes or other facilities for various reasons, and those who are not able to be vaccinated for specific reasons.

OUTDOOR ROSARY AT ST. MARY'S

with the beginning of May, the month of the Blessed Mother, we will be praying the Rosary in English, Spanish and Portuguese at 7 pm on Thursdays in front of the statue of the Blessed Mother across Washington St. from Saint Mary's Church in downtown Taunton. All are welcome to attend. We will have masks on & be socially distanced. If you would like, you can bring a folding chair with you.

Requirements to be a Godparent or Sponsor

You must be a confirmed Catholic, at least 16 years old, registered in a parish, and practicing your faith by weekly participation at Mass. If you are married, your marriage must be recognized as valid by the Church. If you are unmarried, you must not be "living together" with someone. Please make an appointment with Deacon Kevin to obtain a sponsor form.

The Mass book will open for January-June 2022 on July 1st. Please note that anyone who celebrated a funeral Mass here during January-June 2021 will automatically have a 1st anniversary Mass designated for your loved one. One may reserve up to 3 Masses during that time frame, but if there are Masses not spoken for yet from July-December, 2021, you are most welcome to book more Masses during that period of time. The donation is \$10 per Mass.

The Catholic Appeal is in full swing, and to date we have raised \$14,390. There is still time to participate! Your contribution helps the Diocese fund vital programs and ministries that serve the needy of southeastern MA, Cape Cod, and the islands-one person and one family at a time. There will no longer be a need to register for Mass. Our capacity will be back to 100%. There will be no pews closed off and all the doors of the church will be unlocked. This is wonderful! We will also not need to sanitize the church after every Mass. We are so grateful to all those who have given their time in making sure everything was safe for everyone. Your help has been so incredibly appreciated!

All Masses are once again back in the church. The last 3:00 PM Sunday Mass will be on 6/27. The last 7:00 PM Saturday Mass will be held on July 10th. As of June 19/20, the dispensation has been lifted, so Mass is once again obligatory, unless you or someone in your household is sick or has been exposed to Covid.

While masks are no longer required, we do ask that those who have not been vaccinated continue wearing masks. We have no way of telling who has been vaccinated or not so we will go on the “honor system”. No one will be asking to see any vaccination cards or asking if you’ve been vaccinated.

Hand sanitizing dispensers will continue to be offered at both the church and parish center, and all are encouraged to use them.

We are going to hold off on bringing up the gifts for a little longer and we will ask that those who are not in the same household only exchange the sign of peace by a gesture rather than a handshake.

For the time being, we will not be using the offertory baskets with the handles since we have not had an opportunity to organize collection ushers at this time. The collection bins will still be located at each of the church doors for you to leave your contribution or you can utilize online giving found on our website. We have certainly felt the “pinch” during this past year. We are so grateful to all who have been able to continue giving and in many cases, giving more. We hope that as more people return to Mass, we will find it a bit easier to cover our ordinary expenses.

Thank you all once again for your support and understanding as we transition back to “normal.”

There will be 2 people assigned to pray for each of the 3 hours. Anyone else who would like to join them in adoration is welcome.

This is a wonderful opportunity to unite our diocese in prayer while simultaneously building faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
