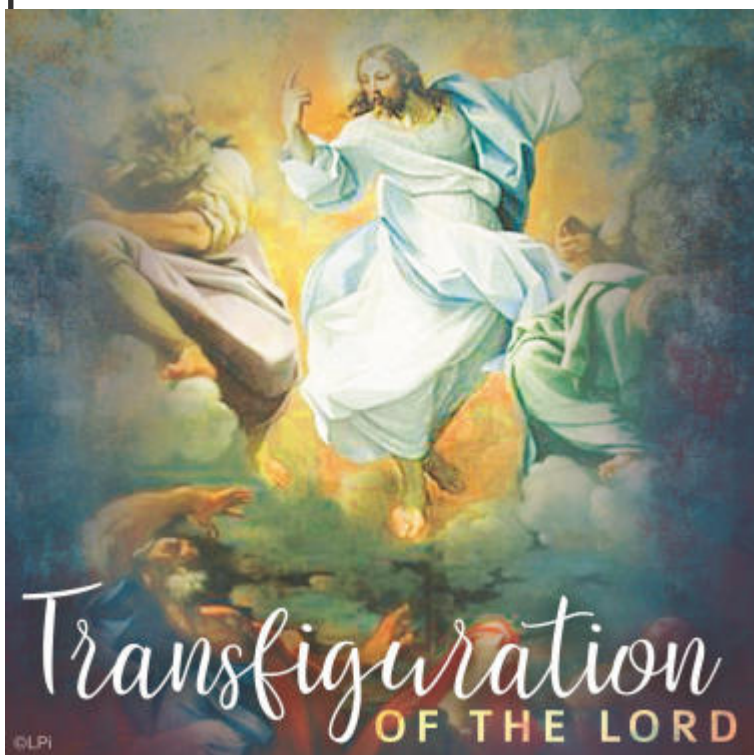

**Bishop da Cunha is asking for our help.** Members of Congress want to take away the Hyde Amendment so that taxpayer dollars will pay for abortions for poor women. When our government offers a woman a free abortion instead of the resources she needs to care for her baby, it's not a "choice," but coercion.
