

Choosing a Confirmation Name

A candidate for confirmation is encouraged to use his or her baptismal name, or select the name of a biblical, beatified, or canonized person as recognized by the Catholic Church. Once the candidate selects the name, they should be familiar with the life of the patron of their choice and the ways in which this person was a witness to Christ and demonstrated discipleship.
