Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to our young people who are celebrating their First Holy Communion this Sunday. Keep their parents and family in prayer so they may continue to celebrate together faithfully and lovingly the Lord's Supper each week.

In the coming weeks, we will be introducing our new website and ability to donate online through PayPal. Having a website is like being present to our community where folks can find information about parish activities, sacraments, classes, links to various Catholic sites, Mass times, etc. We have found a low cost website host and will have information for our sister parish, St. John, as well. We hope with this new website we can better communicate with not only our parishioners, but those who may be interested in what is happening in our parishes.

Another benefit that will be helpful to many is the ability to use credit cards for tithing, donations to various funds, groups, and organizations within the parish. In the past, we tried using credit card services and found them to be very expensive—with buying a machine, annual fees, and percentage fees with each transaction. We are now offering PayPal which is a safe way to make your offering where no financial information from the donor is transferred to the Church. For example, we would, in the past, need to take down the credit card information and have it on file.

Once the site is up and running, we will have a link to PayPal where you can contribute. In the meantime, if you wish to get started using PayPal right away, Rita Rilea can send you the link via email. Many folks may not have a check or cash with them when the tithing plate comes by, so, by giving online they can still participate at the offertory time by placing their empty tithing/building fund envelope with "online giving" or PayPal written on it. This helps donors feel they can be a part of the offertory and most importantly be able to place their offering before the Lord at the Altar.

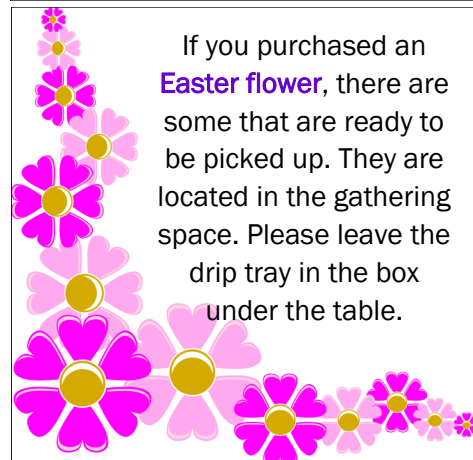
