Dear Parishioners,

We are still dealing with the lighting issues and have now involved our insurance company. The problem is that the switch on the back wall has a transformer in it that has burned out. We have installed several transformers which have also burned out. It was discovered the new transformers - rated at 8 volts and 20 amps - were actually putting out a little over 5.5 volts and not the 8 volts required. At this time, we are looking for transformers that will actually put out the 8 volt requirement. To further complicate this situation, the company which made the parts for this system is no longer in business and the components for the system are no longer being made.

We have contacted our insurance company, but they will only pay to restore the system to its original operating state. They have given us a case number, so we do have our equipment insurance to fall back on if it starts to get expensive.

In the meantime, we are looking at comparing the cost of modifying the system, completely replacing it, or bypassing it altogether. Also being considered is the possible theory that our system may not be compatible with the LED lights we replaced several months ago. The LED lights are the ideal because they last longer and more energy efficient. The insurance company is also looking into this matter with their experts.

As of today, Troy Miller has looked into the matter and is on hold for further instruction. Rick Knowlton, one of our parishioners who has been helping with maintaining our electrical system, has been investigating and advising us on the matter and we hope to resolve this issue soon.

Just as a matter of regular business, our Parish Finance Council will meet Tuesday evening to go over the year-end financial report. The completed and approved report will be published and distributed in the near future.

Thank you again for your genuine concern of the matter and your patience.
