Deaf Ministry (bulletin notice for Des Moines, Adair and Osceola Regions)

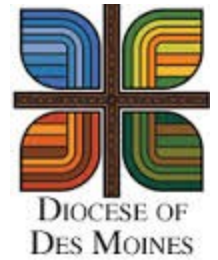
