## Dear Parishioners

Included in today's bulletin you will find a copy of the Summary of Parish Operations report for Fiscal Years 2016 and 2017.

Looking back over a ten-year period (2008-2017), we would like to share some analysis of that data. The following facts are averages of those years.

Number of registered families: 201; annual envelope income: \$114,340 (It is understood that not everyone uses tithing envelopes to make their offerings - this figure includes checks as well); number of registered families who do not

financially support the parish: 49 (25%); annual contribution (envelopes/checks only): \$731; Annual Diocesan Appeal Goal: \$31,630; amount of ADA paid by pledges: \$23,117; amount left to be paid from savings: \$8,513; number of Faith Formation students: 97; annual amount spent on Public Relations: \$886 (i.e., book giveaways at Christmas and Easter); Insurance premiums: \$11,555.

We can make comparisons on all Income/Expense accounts, however, the ones I have listed are the most common indicators of the health of the parish.

Utility costs go up and down with in weather extremes with heating and air conditioning, so it's difficult to say whether the costs are rising, staying the same, or dropping. Other expenses will also vary with each parish with regard to building maintenance and repair, equipment maintenance and repair, and miscellaneous projects. Feel free to ask questions if you have them. And, most importantly, thank you to everyone who is faithfully supporting the parish ministry here at All Saints.

**Altar Servers: \$25.00**

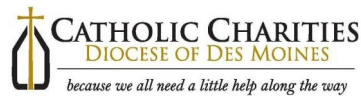
