Pope Francis has named the Archdiocese of Vancouver's Vicar General, Father Joseph Phuong Nguyen, as the new Bishop of Kamloops. Father Nguyen will take over from Bishop David Monroe, who retires having reached the mandatory retirement age of 75. Bishop Monroe has served Kamloops since 2002 and, like his successor, is a former vicar general of the Archdiocese of Vancouver.
