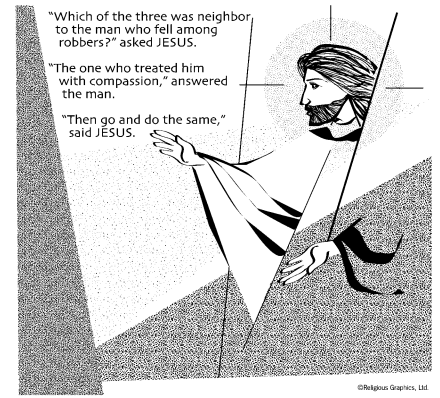

9th ANNUAL ASHOK MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT AND FAIR

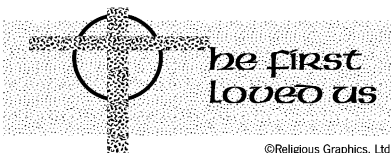
