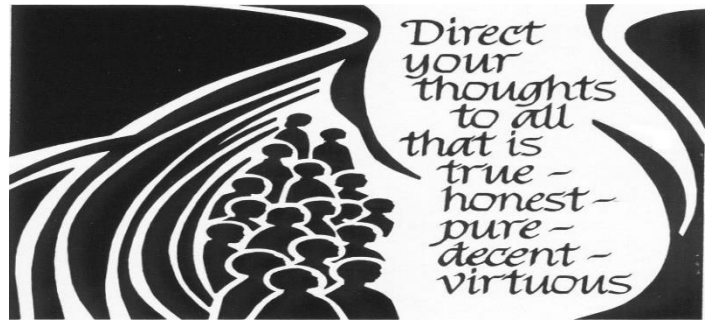


SERRA CLUB
