### **ITINERARY – MARCH FOR LIFE**

March for Life, Victoria on Thursday, May 9 for those who signed up to attend.

**Departure:** Meet at I.C. Parish at 7:45am. We will depart at 8am in two mini-vans for Sacred Heart Church, Ladner. 9am Mass at Sacred Heart, followed by departure on their school bus for the ferry. Disembark ferry and board other buses arranged by Sacred Heart to March for Life, Victoria. Lunch at Centennial Park, just before the start of the March at 1:15pm.

**Arrival to I.C.:** Leave at 3:30pm in front of the BC Museum and board the same buses to catch the 5pm ferry back to Tsawwassen. Should be back at Immaculate Conception by 7:30pm.

**Cost:** Adults: \$20 for bus fare (return trip)  
\$30 for ferry (return trip)

Seniors (age 65+): \$20 for bus fare (return trip)  
Ferry is free for seniors.

**IMPORTANT - Seniors must show their Care Card or Driver's Licence at the ferry terminals to prove age.**
