USE OF SUNDAY OFFERTORY ENVELOPES

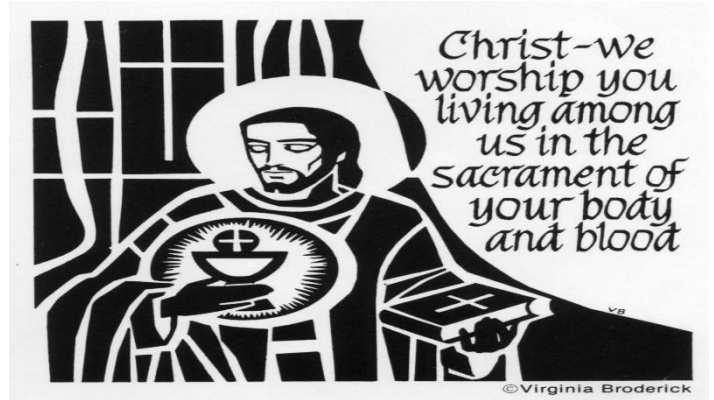
