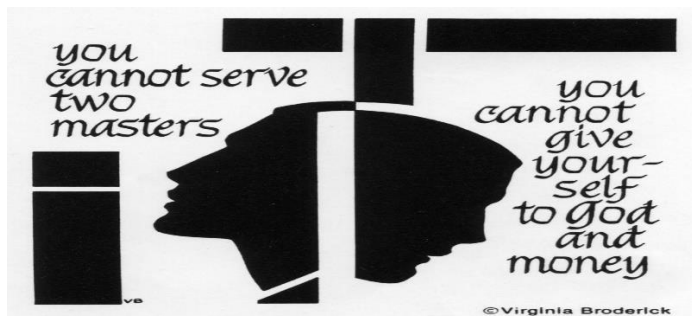
### LEGION OF MARY (JUNIORS)
