St. Charles Parish family has the opportunity next weekend, Jan 18 & 19, to "spiritually" adopt a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all newly conceived babies are allowed to be born. In fact, more than 4,000 babies lose their lives to abortion each day. It is these babies you are being asked to "adopt". You may "adopt" a child individually, or as a family. You will be asked to name the child for whom you will be praying, thereby giving the baby the humanity he or she deserves. Holy cards will be in the pews with a small prayer to be said each day for your baby, plus we ask for you to say one Hail Mary for the parents of your child. We also ask you to take a blue or pink tag, with your child's name on it and hang it on the "Tree of Life" in the front of church. There will be monthly reports on the bulletin board in the back of church on the development of your baby. Your child will be born in the month of October.
