Spiritual Communion and Penance Because we do not have access to the Holy Mass and Communion, I commend the devout practice of Spiritual communion entering spiritually into the many masses being offered by the ordained daily throughout our international world. Disposing ourselves rightly to receive Holy Communion, that is, when we are in the state of grace, not conscious of any mortal sin which we have committed. If we have not yet been forgiven in the Sacrament of Penance, and desire to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion but are unable to do so, we unite ourselves spiritually with these many Holy Sacrifices of the Mass, praying to Our Eucharistic Lord the words of Saint Alphonsus Liquori: **(“Since I am unable now to receive the sacramentally, come at least Spiritually into my heart.”) Spiritual communion is a beautiful expression of love for Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.** It will not fail to bring to us abundant grace. If you are conscious of having committed a mortal sin and are unable to have access to the Sacrament of Confession/Penance/Reconciliation, the church invites us to make an act of perfect contrition, that is, of sorrow for sin, which “arises from a love by which God is loved above all else”. An act of perfect contrition “obtain forgiveness of mortal sins if it includes the firm resolution to have recourse to sacramental confession as soon as possible” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1452) An act of perfect contrition disposes our soul for Spiritual Communion.
