 The average of the **39 families** per envelope was **\$41.92**
 Cash received in the weekly collection basket was **\$570.00**

Due to Mass Times Changing at St. Charles there will no longer be a 10:30am Sunday Morning Mass beginning Sept 12th. St. Charles had to rearrange some of your Mass Intentions to different Mass times or different dates all together. Since we only have two Masses on the weekend one must always be said for our Parishioners. Please watch the bulletin for these changes. With this being said St. Charles does have open Mass Intentions open for the Wed evening Mass with Fr. Shaun beginning on Wed Sept 23rd at 6:00pm. The cost for a Mass is \$10.00 There are Mass Intention envelopes in back of Church. You can drop them in the collection basket or mail your request to St. Charles office. I am sorry for any inconvenience this may cause some of you. We are only allowed to have one Mass Intention per Mass.

As you may already have heard there will be changes coming to the Mass times at St. Charles starting Tuesday September 08th, 2020. Fr. Shaun will be having a Wednesday evening Mass starting at 6:00pm on Wednesday Sept 09th, 2020. There no longer will be a Friday 7:00am Mass. The last Friday morning Mass will be on Friday September 04th, 2020. St. Charles Mass times on Saturday evening will remain at 5:00pm and on Sunday there will only be one Mass at 8:30am. St. Charles will no longer have a 10:30am due to Fr. Shaun having a 10:30am Sunday Mass at St. Nicholas. **Fr. Shaun will here confession starting on Wed evening Sept 09th at 5:15pm until 6:00pm.**

All Parishioners of St. Charles are welcome to return to Mass. Coming to mass on Saturday and Sunday is basically the decision of the parishioner and their intimacy with God. The sacramental celebration is open for all. The Church welcomes every one and we will make space available as best we can try to keep as best as we can a safe distance.
