St. Charles Cemetery Capital Campaign Fund as of Nov 05th 2020 has collected

\$4,670.00 The total amount needed for the St. Charles Cemetery Capital Campaign is **\$43,000** Please be generous and donate towards this Campaign Fund that will upgrade St. Charles Cemetery We have had 15 Families donate to The St. Charles Cemetery Capital Campaign Fund. There are 190 Families Registered as St. Charles Parishioners.

Here is an update on the St. Charles Cemetery Project from the St. Charles Cemetery Committee. Paul Bruner, Nick Bergmann, and Bart Gauck.

1. The Columbarium is ordered and slated to arrive to their shop approximately 11/30/20. The vendor will offload and place onto the prepared footer. The placement will depend on the weather – totally dry or frozen.
2. The remaining portion of the project consisting of Paving the existing driveway and the adding of 2 new gravel driveways will be tabled until Spring of 2021.
3. The money donated to the Cemetery Campaign project will be placed into a special marked account. The funds donated will go to the final payment of the Columbarium. If a balance is still left over, the remaining funds will be deducted from the General Checking account.
4. Council will review the current state of the driveway and provide Winter maintenance if required.
