St. Charles Collection for Jan 24th, 2021

The New Budget for 2020 / 2021 is **\$3,030.00 per week.**

Collection last weekend was **\$1,533.00**

St. Charles parishioners were **under budget by \$-1,497.00**

There were only **40 families** who used their envelopes last week.

The average of the **40 families** per envelope was **\$35.10**

Cash received in the weekly collection basket was **\$464.00**

Parish Participation in using their weekly envelopes is **21%**
