The New Budget for 2020 / 2021 is **\$3,030.00 per week**.

Collection last weekend was **\$ 2,175.00**

There were only **39 families** who used their envelopes last week.

The average of the **39 families** per envelope was **\$49.49**

Cash received in the weekly collection basket was **\$ 545.00**

United Catholic Appeal for St. Charles for 2020 / 2021 goal is \$10,736 and as of 02-16-2021 St. Charles has pledged \$8,880.00. This is 83% of our goal. This from only 24 Families of St. Charles, or 13.0% of Parishioners of St. Charles.
