Milan CARES is a new “non profit organization serving the Milan community for the purpose of building today’s leaders for a stronger community”. This organization includes individuals from the Milan school corporation, business owners, church members and people who genuinely care about the health and well-being of our community. One of the most urgent needs this group identified for the students of the community was the need for an after-school tutoring program. There are approximately 80 students that take part in this program after school where they receive assistance with school work but also in developing relationships with caring adults. Some students are in very difficult situations and need positive influences and encouragement. This group is reaching out to every church within the town of Milan to recruit willing individuals who would like to make a difference and assist these young people.
