Milan CARES is a new "non profit organization serving the Milan community for the purpose of building today's leaders for a stronger community". This organization includes individuals from the Milan school corporation, business owners, church members and people who genuinely care about the health and well-being of our community. One of the most urgent needs this group identified for the students of the community was the need for an after-school tutoring program. There are approximately 80 students that take part in this program after school where they receive assistance with school work but also in developing relationships with caring adults. This group is reaching out to every church within the town of Milan to recruit willing individuals who would like to make a difference and assist these young people. Through this tutoring program, the goal is to build stronger, confident, achieving children in Milan schools and to build a stronger community by supporting kids who need it. Tutoring sessions will be Tuesdays and Thursdays every week, starting August 31, 3pm to 4pm at every grade level in the three school buildings. Flyers will be posted in church and throughout town. Your assistance isn't required every session so your attendance can be flexible. Please consider becoming a part of this worthwhile program to assist students who need support and encouragement.
