



Priest Personnel Update

Father James Grebe, who has been serving as administrator of Nativity of Our Lord Parish in Pensacola since July 1, 2018, has requested to step down from his role. His term as administrator will end on August 31, 2019. After that date, Father Grebe will continue to serve as a priest in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee.

The announcement was made by Father Grebe to Nativity of Our Lord Parish at all of the weekend Masses on August 17 and August 18.

Bishop William A. Wack, CSC, has asked Bishop Martin D. Holley (Bishop Emeritus, Diocese of Memphis) to serve as temporary administrator of the parish, and he has graciously agreed. He will begin this ministry on September 1, 2019, until a permanent administrator/pastor is appointed.

Father Michael Flynn will remain in his role as part-time parochial vicar of Nativity of Our Lord.
