Divide each spelling word into syllables.</p> <p>2D. Write a newspaper article using ten of your spelling words.</p> <p>2E. Write similes and/or metaphors using ten of your spelling words.</p> <p>2F. Classify each spelling word according to its part of speech (ex. noun, verb, adjective...).</p>	<p>3A. Write a short story using all of your spelling words.</p> <p>3B. Create a cartoon strip using at least at least fifteen spelling words.</p> <p>3C. Use each spelling word in a sentence that shows its meaning.</p> <p>3D. Write the definition of each spelling word using a dictionary.</p> <p>3E. Write a conversation between two people that includes at least fifteen spelling words.</p> <p>3F. Make a crossword puzzle on graph paper that includes the definition clues for at least fifteen of your spelling words.</p>
