Studio Policies

Overview

Within the course of a semester, we will be studying the Elements of Art and Principles of Design through various hands-on projects. The exploration of media includes, but is not limited to, pencil, ink, watercolor, colored pencils, acrylic paint, collage, and oil pastel. In addition to creating art, this class will also touch on Art History, as we will be discussing the social, cultural, and historical roles of art across the world. Throughout the semester, we will hold class-wide critiques and write artists' statements in order to describe, interpret and evaluate the value of our own works and the works of others.

1. Come to class prepared with a pencil, eraser and your sketchbook everyday.
2. You are responsible for your materials as well as maintenance and cleanliness of the classroom.
3. This is a safe zone classroom. Bullying, teasing, and negative commentary are not welcome in this room.
4. This classroom enforces school rules and regulations.
5. Cell Phones may NOT be used.
6. Students will not be permitted to take projects home until graded. Any student in need of extra help or extra time on a project should arrange to come to the art room after school or during study hall.
7. Students may choose to bring a smock (oversized t-shirt or apron) to protect clothing while using messy materials. These items should be kept in your lockers before and after class.

Grading

30% Projects (Tests)

Craftsmanship - quality of care taken in the production of the work.

Creativity/Composition - planning & execution of the design, use of materials and overall layout of the work.

Lesson Objectives - each lesson will have different criteria that will be clearly explained

Presentations - most projects will be presented to the class.

A grading rubric will be posted in the classroom for each project for students to reference.

5% Participation/Preparation

Students are expected to work diligently on each project. If a student should finish before the due date the student is expected to work on Art Cards (this will be explained at the start of the semester) or on their Sketchbook assignments for the month. Other options may be given throughout the semester.

20%each Homework & Sketchbooks (Quizzes)

Students are required to complete sketchbook assignments for each month. The assignments will be posted on Google Classroom. Some months will have two or three sketch assignments while others will have one in depth assignment. Students will be required to submit the sketch or sketches on a given date on Google Classroom. Sketches are graded on effort and execution of the assignment.

25% Quarterly Exam

Students are required to complete a quarterly exam, which may consist of a written assignment or PowerPoint presentation.

Course Objectives

Have knowledge of and be able to use the Elements of Art in design.

Have Knowledge of and be able to use the Principles of Design in art.

Explore various types of media including, but not limited to, pencil, watercolor, colored pencils, acrylic paint, collage and oil pastel.

Discuss Art History, as well as the social, cultural, and historical roles of art across the world.
