

**ALTAR SERVER** REFERENCE **MANUAL** 

Mary Queen Catholic Church

Thank you for being an altar server at Mary Queen Catholic Church. This is a great honor and responsibility that must be taken seriously. This manual was designed to complement the in-person annual training that is conducted for all new servers and returning servers. Please contact your altar server ministry coordinator if you have any questions about the content of this manual.

#### IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Dress appropriately, including dress shoes
- Arrive 20 minutes prior to Mass
- Sign in when you arrive
- Select an alb that falls to your ankles
- Tie the cincture on your left side
- Keep hands in prayer position
- Participate in the Mass fully
- Watch the priest/deacon/acolyte closely during the Mass in case they need your help
- Enjoy yourself
- Learn from mistakes (they will happen!)

Collect (Opening Prayer)		Near the end of the Gloria, receive the Roman Missal from the Acolyte. When directed, carry to the Priest and stand to his front and left, holding the book to your left (so he can see the entire congregation).  After he recites the prayer, close the book and return it to the table, carrying it reverently with the cover facing outward.	
Children's Liturgy Dismissal  9:30 and 11:30 with Children's Liturgy only	(Children's Liturgy Only): Immediately after the Collect, retrieve the Processional Cross, bow behind the altar, exit down the ramp and into the center aisle. Stand behind the assembling children facing the altar. When the priest dismisses the children, lead them to the Children's Liturgy Room and leave cross in stand. Return to your seat through the Sacristy.		

After 2 <sup>nd</sup> Reading Gospel Reading		Proceed to the Gospel candle (Server 1 goes to the far candle, Server 2 to the near), bowing behind the altar when you pass. Remove the candle from its stand and:  1. If the Book of the Gospels is on its stand under the crucifix, stay where you are.  2. If the Book of the Gospels is on the altar, Server 2 will lead Server 1 to the marks behind the altar. (Server 1 should cross behind the crucifix)  Follow the Book of the Gospels when the Deacon presents it and moves to the ambo. Take your positions behind the ambo as the Gospel is proclaimed.  When the Gospel ends, turn to the inside, walk to the candle stands, and replace the candles.  Cross behind the crucifix (1st), bow behind the altar together, and return to your seat.
Homily; Profession of Faith (Creed); Prayer of the Faithful (petitions)  9:30 and 11:30 with Children's Liturgy only	(Children's Liturgy Only): When homily ends, go through the Sacristy to collect the children from Children's Liturgy. After the last petition is read, release the children and return to the sacristy via the ramp. Replace the Processional Cross in its stand and move to your seat.	

Preparation of the altar	Assist Deacon and Acolyte in setting up the altar	Bring the Roman Missal / Sacramentary (and its stand, if needed by the priest) to the altar.	
Offertory (Gifts)	Take the water cruet from the credence table, holding the bottom so the Deacon can grab the handle, and wait beside the altar. When the Deacon turns to take the cruet, hand it to him (with stopper removed). When he hands it back to you, return it to the credence table and replace stopper.  Immediately take the water pitcher, water bowl, and towel over your arm and move to the Priest and wait for him to turn to you. When he turns, step towards him and pour water over his hands. When he is done drying his hands return the pitcher, bowl and towel to the credence table.	When Acolyte goes to get the collection basket, cross in front of the chairs to the base of the steps and stand immediately to the Deacon's left.  The Deacon will hand you the ciborium which you will hand to Server 2.  He will then hand you the wine flagon which you will keep.  Nod to the gift bearers when the Deacon bows and follow him when he returns to the altar and wait next to Server 2.  When the Deacon takes the flask, return to your seat (crossing behind the chairs).	When the Acolyte goes to get the collection basket, cross in front of the chairs to the base of the steps and stand to Server 1's left.  Server 1 will hand you the ciborium.  Nod to the gift bearers when the Deacon bows and follow Server 1 when he returns to the altar and wait.  When the Deacon take the ciborium, return to your seat (crossing behind the chairs)

	<b>SERVER 1</b> : When returning from Communion, if the Roman Missal is still on the altar, retrieve it and place it on the table near your seat in preparation for the closing prayer.	
Reception of Communion	the ramp in single file, stopping to bow together at the altar when you pass. Continue to process in single file behind the altar, bowing again, and return to your seats and kneel in prayer until the Eucharist is returned to the Tabernacle.

Prayer After Communion		Receive the Roman Missal from the Acolyte. When directed, carry to the Priest and stand as you did for the Collect. After the prayer, close the book and return it to the table, carrying it reverently	
Recessional	When the Priest says the Mass has ended, retrieve the Processional Cross  Follow Server 1 behind the altar. Wait for the Acolyte then bow together. Follow the procession down the ramp. Stand at the bottom of the rosette and face the altar.	When the Priest says to retrieve the procession.  Lead Cross Bearer and Server 2 behind the altar, lined up with the gold cross, and wait for the Acolyte then bow together.  Lead the procession down the ramp and stand next to the front pew on the side of the church closer to the Tabernacle, facing the altar.	
	The Priest and Deacon will come down the steps and turn to face the altar in prayer. Nod your head when they bow then turn and slowly lead the procession from the church.

# Key Activities by Position (Cheat Sheet):

# **Cross Bearer:**

- Lead procession into Mass with cross
- Lead children to children's Liturgy room (9:30 & 11:30 only) after Collect and return to Sanctuary
- After Homily return to Children's Liturgy room
- After Petitions release the children from the children's Liturgy room and return to Sanctuary
- Assist in preparing the altar for the Liturgy of the Eucharist
- Bring the water cruet to the altar, wait for use, then return it to table
- Bring the water pitcher, bowl and towel to the Priest for hand washing
- Lead the procession from the church

### Server 1:

- After processing in and bowing with Priest, lead procession onto the altar
- Hold Roman Missal for the Priest during the Collect (Opening Prayer)
- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading, hold the farther Gospel candle for the Gospel reading
- Bring the Roman Missal (and stand) to the altar during altar preparation
- Receive gifts with Priest / Deacon (wine)
- Ring the bells during Eucharistic Prayer
- Lead servers to receive Communion
- Retrieve the Roman Missal after Communion (if it is on altar)
- Hold Roman Missal for the Priest during the Closing Prayer
- Lead procession off the altar at the end of Mass

## Server 2:

- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading, hold the nearer Gospel candle for the Gospel reading
- Lead Server 1 to behind the altar following the Book of the Gospels
- Receive gifts with Priest / Deacon (ciborium)
