**From the Pastor:** Tuesday June 21<sup>st</sup> is the feast day of St. Aloysius Gonzaga. He was born into an Italian aristocratic family in the 16<sup>th</sup> century and had decided to enter religious life when he was 9. He entered the Jesuits at the age of 18 and died at age 23 while serving in a hospital during a time of plague.

St. Aloysius is the patron for Catholic youth because of the holy life that he led: he always kept serving and pleasing God as the purpose of his life. His statue is located in the wing above the Blessed Mother altar.
