From the Pastor: The days between the Resurrection and the Ascension of the Lord by Pope St. Leo the Great excerpted from *The Liturgy of the Hours*:

Their enlightened hearts catch the flame of faith, and lukewarm as they have been, they are made to burn while the Lord unfolds the Scriptures. How much more blessed is that opening of their eyes, to the glorification of their nature, than the time when our first parents' eyes were opened to the disastrous consequences of their transgression.
