From the Pastor: St Augustine was a brilliant theologian and his works are still read some 1,700 years after his death. His work, *Confessions* describes his early life and how he wandered from the faith and then returned after the death of a friend reminded him of the fragility of our lives and how, sooner or later, death awaits us all. The following excerpt describes the consolation that he found in the Eucharist:

O eternal Truth, true Love, and beloved Eternity, you are my God, and for you I sigh day and night. As I first began to know you, you lifted me up and...I seemed to hear your voice from on high: "I am the food of the mature: grow, then, and you shall eat me. You will not change me into yourself like bodily food; but you will be changed into me".

The Gospels for the last four Sundays have been pointing us in the direction of the Holy Eucharist. We know that we were created in God's image. The graces that come to us from worthy receipt of the Eucharist will help us to live as a reflection of God's image moving closer to Him every day in this life so that we will be worthy to share eternal life with Him.

Our Parishioner Chris Livelsberger begins his 4th year (of 5) studying to become a deacon. Please remember him in your prayers that he may be strengthened by the Holy Spirit as he continues his diaconate studies.
