He was born in Hanover and attended New Oxford Senior High School, his home Parish is St. Vincent de Paul, Hanover. After high school he attended Western Maryland College (now known as McDaniel College) in Westminster MD, receiving a degree in Religious Studies and Foreign Language. After college, Fr. Clark attended St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, PA and received his Master of Divinity and Master of Arts degree. He was ordained to the Diaconate in 2002 by Bishop Nicholas Dattilo and to the Priesthood by Bishop David Zubik from the Diocese of Pittsburgh. Fr. Clark is a diocesan priest of Hbg. His first assignment was St. Joan of Arc in Hershey, PA where he remained for 4 years as the Parochial Vicar. During most of his time there, Fr. Clark also served as

Chaplain to Bishop McDevitt High School in Hbg. Fr. Clark later went on to study Canon Law at the request of Bishop Rhoades at the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C., where in 2010 he received his JCL (Licentiate) in church law. In the past Fr. Clark has been in residence at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Parish and at the Cathedral Parish of St. Patrick, both in Hbg. Fr. Clark is currently the Pastor of St. Matthew Parish, Dauphin and the Judicial Vicar of the Diocese, overseeing the work and ministry of the Tribunal and Canonical Services, including Matrimonial Concerns. He is also the Bishop's Liaison to the St. Thomas More Society of Central Pennsylvania. He is a Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus. Join us in prayer and adoration of Our Lord at the 40 Hours Eucharistic Devotions this year.
