

### Mass Attendance Protocols

- Masks must be used at all times in the church. Masks are available from ushers if needed.
- Parishioners at a higher risk of COVID are urged not to attend Mass. **Those who in any way feel ill should not enter the church.**
- Hand sanitizer is available and should be used upon entering the church.
- Holy Communion **should only be received by your hand**; and not by the mouth.
- There should be no congregating in the church vestibule before and after Mass.
- The church has designated seating arrangements based upon the number of attendees in your group, e.g., singles; couples; families of three; or a larger grouping. Please follow the guidance of ushers regarding seating.
- Social distancing must be adhered to during the entire Mass to include a safe social distance while on line to receive Communion.
- No physical contact during the Sign of Peace will be permitted.
- Holy Water fonts will be empty to avoid cross contamination.
- In pew worship aids, e.g., Missals & Hymnals, will not be available. Parishioners are invited to bring their own.
- No paper Bulletins will be distributed. Bulletins are available on our parish web site ([www.HolyRosaryBronx.org](http://www.HolyRosaryBronx.org)).
- The church will be sanitized and disinfected after each Mass.
- Cry Rooms will be closed and locked.
