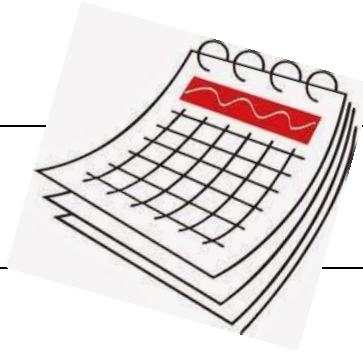

Emergency Childcare Program – S.O.A.R. Time

Our emergency childcare program also called S.O.A.R. Time will begin October 5. Parents were emailed a survey on Friday, September 25. This survey provided us with feedback on the time range for S.O.A.R. Time. On September 28, we sent out information and along with an application to enroll your child into S.O.A.R. Time. It is important that we receive your enrollment form by Thursday October 1.

Times: 8:45AM-4:15PM

During S.O.A.R. Time students will receive enrichment activities such as

- STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)
- Art and Culture
- Fitness
- Academic Support

Students will have access to 2 hours of limited instruction in religion, reading, and math. Students can also access any online learning (comprehensive distance learning) during S.O.A.R. time. We will have devices for students to access their Google Classroom for assignments, announcements, or for any meetings. We are offering all of this support to help parents and students. There are no additional charges or fees. S.O.A.R. Time is included in the monthly tuition. The childcare time is optional.

Comprehensive Distance Learning

We are still following ODE and state regulations for Comprehensive Distance Learning. Under our reopening plan for Comprehensive Distance Learning, we can also offer 2 hours of limited in-person instruction. All cohorts have been moved to the AM. We will no longer provide instruction in the PM. Students can attend for only their 2 hours of limited in-person instruction time and can have access to our Google Classroom without attending S.O.A.R. time. There is a space on the S.O.A.R. enrollment form to select this option. Our program models:

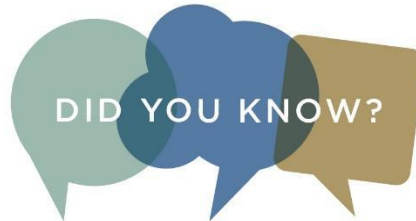


Did you know?

We are starting up a Book It program. When students meet their reading goals, they earn a personal small pizza from Pizza Hut. We are all using the same reading log to keep track of minutes read.

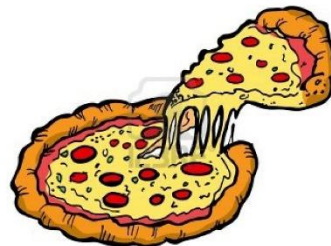
Students can earn reading minutes during S.O.A.R. Time also!

Attendance

This is just a friendly reminder that if your child has been exposed to COVID or is feeling sick please have him/her stay home. We will ask for your child to quarantine for up to 14 days before returning to school. If a student is absent more than 10 days, your child will be dropped from SVDP.
