



Dear Parents or Guardian:

Welcome to Holy Rosary Catholic School. These “**Health Care Procedures**” are to help us accomplish the goal of excellent health and safety of your child while in school or school related events.

Please read carefully, complete and sign & date the forms listed below and return with registration:

1. This letter
 2. TB Student Questionnaire
 3. Student Emergency Information Card
 4. Up-to-date Immunization Record
 5. Health Care Plan
- If your child has a severe health problem as diabetes, asthma, epilepsy, severe allergies, heart conditions or other serious health conditions, **doctor’s orders, health care plans, medication and meeting with teachers, nurse and principal must be done before the child can start school.**
 - Any medication, prescriptions or over-the-counter, needs to have a physician or authorized prescriber and parent signature before the medication can be given at school. Ointments, vitamins, and others are considered to be medication. The prescription medication must have a pharmacy label that matches orders. **All medications must be brought to the school by the parent.** Medication permission forms can be found on the school website (parent section- school forms).
 - All students participating in after school sports activities **MUST have an annual physical signed by their doctor on file at school.** Sports permission forms can be found on the school website (parent section- school forms).

All Catholic schools in The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston comply with the State of Texas Immunization requirements. Up-to date immunization records **must** be returned to the school before registration is complete.

Texas Law requires **Vision, Hearing, Spinal, and Texas Risk Assessment for Type 2 Diabetes** in Children (TRAT2DC) screening to be performed at school.

If screening norms are not met, a referral to a physician will be made.

A student TB Screening Questionnaire or proof the child is under a doctor’s care is required for all students.

A student will be sent home due to illness-Students should be collected within 30 mins of notification. Exclusion and Re-admission Guidelines can be found in the Parent/student handbook.
