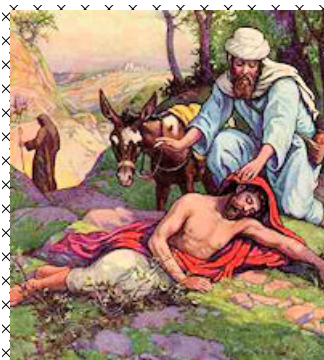

For we know that if our earthly dwelling, a tent, should be destroyed, we have a building from God.

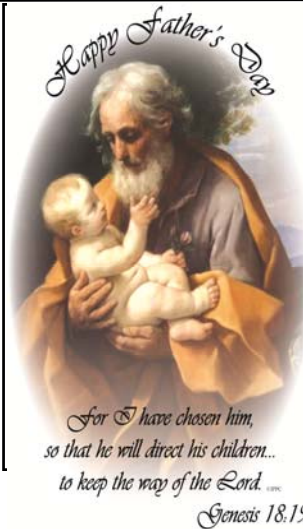
Pro Life actions are the attempt to shore up the earthly tents of our bodies as well as reflect the indestructible buildings of our infinite souls.

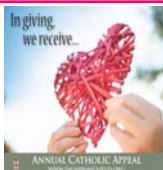
