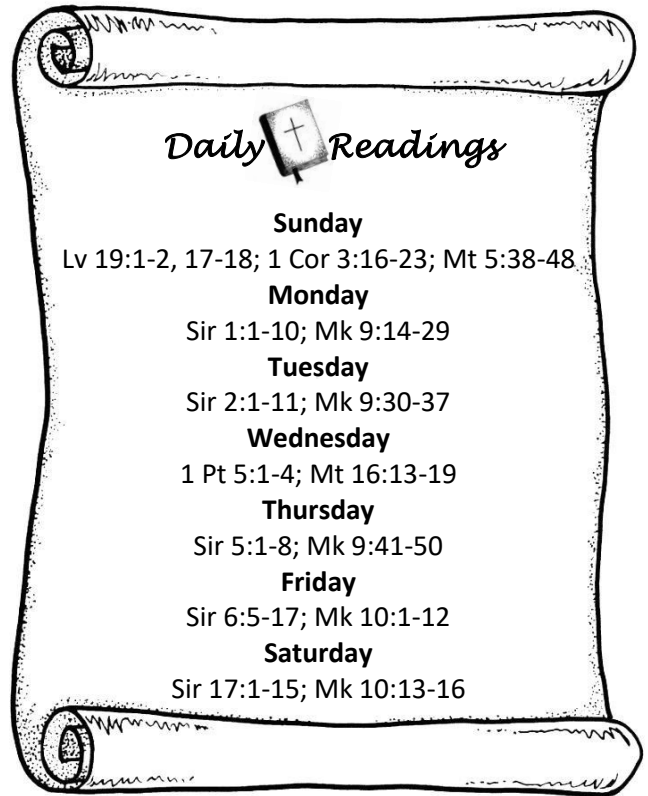

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly



“The Lord said to Moses, ‘Speak to the whole Israelite community, and tell them: ‘Be holy, for I the Lord, your God, am holy.’... You have heard the commandment... But I say to you... offer no resistance to injury... but I say to you love your enemies, pray for your persecutors... you must be perfected as your heavenly father is perfect.”

The letter of the law reads one way, but the spirit of the law as taught by Jesus and which we are to follow demands much more. To turn the other cheek, and eliminate the word “hate” from our life and vocabulary is not easy, but it is His command. We have lived the jubilee year of mercy, being reminded constantly to be perfect, to seek mercy and then reflect it to all. All of us are called to be holy, to walk the path of sanctity, although we seem to put it on a back burner. What God said to Moses, what Jesus taught, is the call of the Holy Father to us today. Through prayer, sacrifice and good works, the road we are on will bring us to the perfection we strive for, the holiness to which the Lord invites us. The few words of Jesus ‘but I say to you...’ should make us think.

“El Señor dijo a Moisés: ‘Habla en estos términos a toda la comunidad de Israel: Ustedes serán santos, porque yo, el Señor su Dios, soy santo... Ustedes han oído el mandamiento... Pero yo les digo que no hagan frente al que les hace mal... Pero yo les digo que amen a sus enemigos, rueguen por sus perseguidores... sean perfectos como es perfecto el Padre que está en el cielo.’”

La ley al pie de la letra se interpreta de un modo, pero el espíritu de la ley como nos lo enseña Jesús y como debemos seguirla demanda mucho más. Volver la otra mejilla, eliminar la palabra “odio” de nuestra vida y vocabulario no es fácil, pero es Su mandamiento. Hemos vivido el Año de Jubileo de la Misericordia, recordándonos constantemente que seamos perfectos, buscando la Misericordia para reflejarla a todos. Somos llamados a ser santos, a andar el camino de la santidad, aunque a menudo lo olvidamos. Lo que Dios dijo a Moisés, lo que Jesús enseñó, es el llamado que nos hace hoy el Santo Padre. A través de la oración, sacrificio y buenas obras, el camino por el que vamos nos traerá a la perfección que buscamos, a la santidad que el Señor nos invita. Las palabras de Jesús: ‘Pero yo les digo...’ deberían hacernos pensar.
