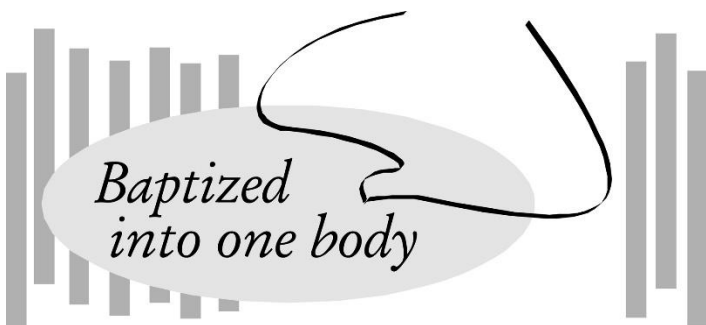

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly
Pentecost Sunday

“Brothers and sisters: No one can say ‘Jesus is Lord’ except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God which produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit...For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body...and we were all given to drink of the one Spirit.”

We proclaim that Jesus is Lord, and everything that goes along with it. He is Savior, Teacher, Brother. Because the Spirit dwells in me, I do not hesitate to make this assertion.

Take a moment, to reflect upon the gifts I see in others. They too are signs that the Spirit dwells in that person. Do not hesitate to mention your respect for them because of the presence of the Spirit and the gifts they possess. It might be the special moment to awaken in them the need to continue to exercise these God given gifts. Do I find charity, kindness, humility, the spirit of evangelization, holiness in them? Pray for them, help awaken that presence of the Spirit in them.

A Plenary Indulgence

The Apostolic Penitentiary, through the authority of the Supreme Pontiff, has granted a Plenary Indulgence to all of those who are suffering from the coronavirus or those who are caring for those who are ill, and additionally to all those subject to quarantine during this time of grave difficulty. In order to obtain the Indulgence, which is the remission before God of guilt for sins already forgiven, the faithful are to observe the devotions and disposition outlined in the decree:

The Plenary Indulgence is granted to the faithful suffering from Coronavirus, who are subject to quarantine by order of the health authority in hospitals or in their own homes if, with a spirit detached from any sin, they unite spiritually through the media to the celebration of Holy Mass, the recitation of the Holy Rosary, to the pious practice of the Way of the Cross or other forms of devotion, or if at least they will recite the Creed, the Lord's Prayer and a pious invocation to the Blessed Virgin Mary, offering this trial in a spirit of faith in God and charity towards their brothers and sisters, with the will to fulfil the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the Holy Father's intentions), as soon as possible. Health care workers, family members and all those who, following the example of the Good Samaritan, exposing themselves to the risk of contagion, care for the sick of Coronavirus according to the words of the divine Redeemer: "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends" (John 15: 13), will obtain the same gift of the Plenary Indulgence under the same conditions.

The Holy Father has provided this Plenary Indulgence in order for the suffering and those who selflessly labor in the care of the sick are united ever more closely with Christ the healer and reliant on the all-powerful and never failing mercy of God.

All to the contrary notwithstanding. Given this 20th day of March, 2020.

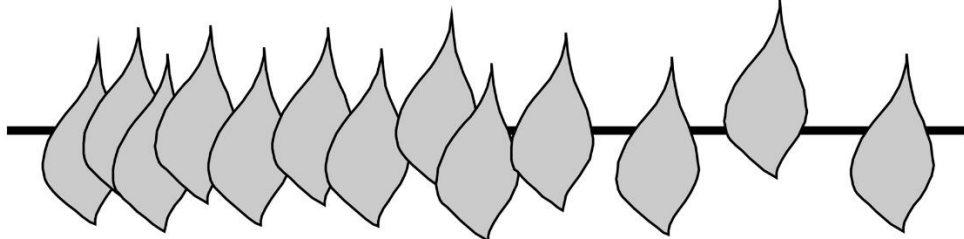

SU PALABRA HOY por el Reverendo William J. Reilly

Domingo de Pentecostés

“Amados hermanos: Nadie puede decir: ‘Jesús es el Señor’, si no está impulsado por el Espíritu Santo. Ciertamente, hay diversidad de dones, pero todos proceden del mismo Espíritu. Hay diversidad de ministerios, pero un sólo Señor. Hay diversidad de actividades, pero es el mismo Dios el que realiza todo en todos. En cada uno, el Espíritu se manifiesta para el bien común... todos hemos sido bautizados en un solo Espíritu para formar un solo Cuerpo... y todos hemos bebido de un mismo Espíritu.”

Proclamamos que Jesús es el Señor, y todo lo que eso implica. Es Salvador, Maestro, Hermano. Ya que el Espíritu vive en mí, no dudo en hacer esta afirmación.

Tome un momento para reflexionar sobre los dones que ve en otros. Esas son señales de que el Espíritu habita en ellos. No vacile en expresar su respeto por ellos por la presencia del Espíritu y los dones que poseen. Puede ser el momento adecuado para despertar en ellos la necesidad de continuar ejerciendo estos dones divinos. ¿Encuentro dones de caridad, amabilidad, humildad, el espíritu de evangelización, santidad en ellos? Oremos para que todos éstos ayuden a despertar la presencia del Espíritu en ellos.

En ausencia de Misa, por favor recen el Acto de comunión espiritual: Jesús mío, creo que estás presente en el Santísimo Sacramento. Te amo por encima de todas las cosas y deseo recibirte en mi alma. Como ahora no puedo recibirte sacramentalmente, entra al menos espiritualmente en mi corazón. Te abrazo como si ya estuvieras allí, y me uno completamente a Ti. Nunca permitas que me separe de Ti. Amén.

Nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, ha compuesto esta oración en Busca de la poderosa intercesión de nuestra Santísima Madre durante este tiempo del coronavirus: Oh María, tu resplandesces siempre en nuestro camino como signo de salvación y de esperanza. Confiamos en ti, Salud de los enfermos, que junto a la cruz te asociaste al dolor de Jesús, manteniendo firme tu fe. Tú...sabes lo que necesitamos y estamos seguros de que proveerás para que, como en Caná de Galilea pueda volver la alegría y la fiesta después de este momento de prueba.
