HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

The Most Holy Trinity

“Having come down in a cloud, the Lord stood with Moses there and proclaimed his name, ‘Lord.’ Thus the Lord passed before him and cried out, ‘The Lord, the Lord, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.’ Moses then bowed down to the ground in worship. Then he said, ‘If I find favor with you O Lord, do come along in our company.’”

How exciting is the description of Moses’ encounter with God. He reveals His name and we discover the attributes of God – mercy, graciousness, kindly and faithful. It is no surprise that there is an invitation to accompany his people on their journey.

It is the gift of accompaniment which continues with us as we encounter our God. The same characteristics from the book of Exodus, are the driving force for us to grow in holiness. As God revealed Himself to Moses He manifests Himself to us, for ‘God so loved the world He gave His only Son.’

A Plenary Indulgence

The Apostolic Penitentiary, through the authority of the Supreme Pontiff, has granted a Plenary Indulgence to all of those who are suffering from the coronavirus or those who are caring for those who are ill, and additionally to all those subject to quarantine during this time of grave difficulty. In order to obtain the Indulgence, which is the remission before God of guilt for sins already forgiven, the faithful are to observe the devotions and disposition outlined in the decree:

The Plenary Indulgence is granted to the faithful suffering from Coronavirus, who are subject to quarantine by order of the health authority in hospitals or in their own homes if, with a spirit detached from any sin, they unite spiritually through the media to the celebration of Holy Mass, the recitation of the Holy Rosary, to the pious practice of the Way of the Cross or other forms of devotion, or if at least they will recite the Creed, the Lord's Prayer and a pious invocation to the Blessed Virgin Mary, offering this trial in a spirit of faith in God and charity towards their brothers and sisters, with the will to fulfil the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the Holy Father's intentions), as soon as possible. Health care workers, family members and all those who, following the example of the Good Samaritan, exposing themselves to the risk of contagion, care for the sick of Coronavirus according to the words of the divine Redeemer: "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends" (John 15: 13), will obtain the same gift of the Plenary Indulgence under the same conditions.

The Holy Father has provided this Plenary Indulgence in order for the suffering and those who selflessly labor in the care of the sick are united ever more closely with Christ the healer and reliant on the all-powerful and never failing mercy of God.

UNA FRESCA PERSPECTIVA DE LAS LECTURAS DOMINICALES

SU PALABRA HOY por el Reverendo William J. Reilly

La Santísima Trinidad

“El Señor descendió en la nube, y permaneció allí, junto a él. Moisés invocó el nombre del Señor. El Señor pasó delante de él y exclamó: ‘El Señor es un Dios compasivo y bondadoso, lento para enojarse, y pródigo en amor y fidelidad.’ Moisés cayó de rodillas y se postró, diciendo: ‘Si realmente me has brindado tu amistad, dignate, Señor, ir en medio de nosotros.’”

La descripción de Moisés de su encuentro con Dios es fascinante. El revela su nombre y descubrimos los atributos de Dios: compasión, bondad, amabilidad y fidelidad. No es sorpresa que lo invitara a acompañar a su gente durante la jornada.

Es el don de compañía el que continúa con nosotros cuando encontramos a Dios. Las mismas características del libro de Exodo son las fuerzas que nos llevan a crecer en santidad. Así como Dios se reveló a Moisés, El se nos manifiesta a nosotros, puesto que ‘Dios amó tanto al mundo, que entregó a su Hijo único.’

En ausencia de Misa, por favor recen el Acto de comunión espiritual: Jesús mío, creo que estás presente en el Santísimo Sacramento. Te amo por encima de todas las cosas y deseo recibirte en mi alma. Como ahora no puedo recibirte sacramentalmente, entra al menos espiritualmente en mi corazón. Te abrazo como si ya estuvieras allí, y me uno completamente a Ti. Nunca permitas que me separe de Ti. Amén.

Nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, ha compuesto esta oración en Busca de la poderosa intercesión de nuestra Santísima Madre durante este tiempo del coronavirus: Oh María, tu resplandeces siempre en nuestro camino como signo de salvación y de esperanza. Confiamos en ti, Salud de los enfermos, que junto a la cruz te asociaste al dolor de Jesús, manteniendo firme tu fe. Tú...sabes lo que necesitamos y estamos seguros de que proveerás para que, como en Caná de Galilea pueda volver la alegría y la fiesta después de este momento de prueba. Ayúdanos, Madre del Divino Amor, a conformarnos a la voluntad del Padre y hacer lo que nos diga Jesús que ha tomado sobre sí nuestros sufrimientos y se ha cargado con nuestros dolores para llevarnos, a través de la cruz a la alegría de la resurrección. Amén.
