**THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20a**

The prophet Malachi warned that the time would come when all the evil people would be punished. He then speaks of the arrival of "the sun of justice, with its healing rays," believed by most to mean Jesus.

**Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12**

Some of the Thessalonians claimed Christ's return was imminent, so they stopped working and asked others for food. Paul describes his willingness to work, so that he would not impose on others. He encourages them to follow his example and earn their own living.

**Gospel: Luke 21:5-19**

Jesus warns of the persecution all Christians will face because of him, and how some will even be put to death. Yet he says they will not be harmed because "by patient endurance you will save your lives." If Jesus' followers are loyal, they will be resurrected and their suffering will end.

The liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council called for the full participation of the laity in the celebration of the Mass. In doing so the Church Fathers turned to the practice of the early Church in which non-ordained men and women had a greater role in that celebration, principally as Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers. Over the centuries those roles became the exclusive realm of the clergy.

We are very fortunate here at St. Charles to have dedicated parishioners serving in the roles of Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Altar Servers, Ushers/Greeters and Choir Members; and yet we could always use more.
