OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

First Reading: Daniel 7:13-14

Daniel describes the one who will appear on the clouds of heaven and receive glory. People of every language will serve this one, and his leadership and community will be his forever.

Second Reading: Revelation 1:5-8

Jesus is so powerful, he is the ruler of kings. He loved us enough to free us from sin, and so he will be glorified forever. He will appear again and be seen by all the people of the earth. God calls himself the first and last, "the One who is and who was and who is to come," reminding all people that God will remain with us always.

Gospel: John 18:33b-37

Pilate asks Jesus if he is a king. Jesus explains that his kingdom is not of this world. Pilate asks again if Jesus is a king, to which he replies, "I came into the world to testify to the truth. Anyone committed to the truth hears my voice."

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William J. Reilly

"Jesus Christ is the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead and the ruler of the kings of the earth. In Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood, who has made us into a kingdom of priests for His God and Father, to Him be glory and power forever. Amen."

On the day of our baptism when the minister took the holy chrism and anointed our foreheads we were told that now we share with Jesus in the threefold role of priest, prophet and king. The name Christ means the anointed one. We often refer to baptism by another name 'christening.'

As we bring the church year to a close, we pledge our loyalty to Jesus Christ, and dedicate ourselves to build the kingdom of Jesus Christ. The many parables taught by Jesus described His kingdom, the church. Many told us of the hidden treasure, as well as the weeds and the wheat. The kingdom of Jesus finds good and bad, strengths and weaknesses, but it's the kingdom of the Lord and we are part of it. Let us build the kingdom of God, as He wishes it to be. May we pray, 'thy kingdom come' with new awareness and deep devotion.

THIS YEAR WE WILL BE HAVING OUR 18th ANNUAL COOKIE WALK FOR OUR PARISH AND SOMETHING NEW. SEVERAL VENDORS WILL ALSO BE SET UP IN THE HALL WITH AN ASSORTMENT OF GIFT IDEAS FOR CHRISTMAS. THE COOKIE WALK IS A FUNDRAISER THAT IS FUN TO DO AND WILL PROVIDE YOU WITH AN ASSORTMENT OF DELICIOUS COOKIES YOU PROBABLY COULDN'T FIND IN ANY BAKERY. ALL THE COOKIES ARE HOMEMADE FROM FAVORITE AND PROBABLY FAMILY HEIRLOOM RECIPES. YOU CAN ENJOY THE COOKIES YOURSELF OR BRING THEM TO WHERE YOU WILL BE ENJOYING CHRISTMAS DINNER AS A SPECIAL TREAT FOR ALL THOSE PRESENT. YOU MIGHT EVEN CONSIDER USING THEM AS A CHRISTMAS PRESENT FOR THE PEOPLE YOU CAN'T DECIDE ON WHAT KIND OF A GIFT TO GET (BECAUSE THEY HAVE EVERYTHING!) WHATEVER THE REASON, PLEASE SUPPORT THIS FUNDRAISER FOR YOUR PARISH. THE COOKIE WALK AND HOLIDAY FUNDRAISER WILL TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY, DECEMBER 8TH FROM 9:30 AM TO 3:00 PM AND WILL BE ADVERTISED ON THE RADIO AND IN OUR LOCAL NEWSPAPERS.

NOW THE FUN PART, WE NEED LOTS OF PEOPLE BAKING BATCHES OF THEIR FAVORITE COOKIES. PLEASE BAKE 4 TO 6 DOZEN COOKIES TO DONATE, NO STORE BOUGHT COOKIES ALLOWED! PLEASE NEATLY WRITE DOWN THE INGREDIENTS ON A HALF SHEET OF PAPER OR INDEX CARD, SO THAT THOSE ALLERGIC TO CERTAIN FOODS WON'T HAVE REACTIONS. (WE ARE NOT ASKING FOR THE RECIPE!) BRING THE COOKIES TO THE CHURCH HALL ON SATURDAY MORNING BY 9 AM. (OR THE DAY BEFORE ON THE RECTORY PORCH.)

HERE IS HOW THE COOKIE WALK WORKS:

YOU TAKE AN EMPTY CONTAINER (WHICH WE SUPPLY) AND WALK BETWEEN THE TABLES THAT ARE SET UP WITH COOKIES. PUT AS MANY COOKIES OF EACH TYPE YOU SELECT INTO YOUR CONTAINER. WHEN YOU ARE FINISHED, TAKE THE CONTAINER TO ONE OF THE CHECKOUTS AND IT WILL BE WEIGHED. THE COOKIES SELL FOR \$7.00 PER POUND. PAY THE CASHIER AND ENJOY THE COOKIES. YOU CAN MIX AND MATCH AS MUCH AS YOU WISH AND FILL AS MANY CONTAINERS AS YOU WISH. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE COOKIES CAN NOT BE PUT BACK, SO WATCH WHAT YOU SELECT. IF YOU WISH TO JUST SIT AND ENJOY A CUP OF COFFEE YOU CAN DO SO FOR \$1.00 AND SELECT ANY THREE COOKIES TO EAT.

PLEASE FILL OUT AND RETURN THE FORM BELOW TO THE RECTORY OR DROP IN THE COLLECTION BASKET ASAP AS TO WHAT VARIETIES OF COOKIES YOU WILL BAKE AND / OR IF YOU ARE WILLING TO ASSIST AT THE COOKIE WALK. EACH BAKER SHOULD MAKE ABOUT 4-6 DOZEN COOKIES OR MORE IF POSSIBLE. DON'T SIGN UP IF YOU ARE NOT GOING TO HONOR YOUR COMMITMENT. THOSE PEOPLE WHO PICKED UP A TRAY FROM THE VESTIBULE LAST YEAR AND DIDN'T BRING ANY COOKIES TO THE COOKIE WALK, RETURN THE TRAY THIS YEAR WITH COOKIES ON IT! THE TRAYS WERE NOT CHRISTMAS GIFTS FOR YOU TO TAKE FOR YOURSELVES!
