Math

 **Math While Cooking** – Pick something to cook or bake with your child. Have your youngster read through the recipe and estimate the prep time. He/She can add that to the cooking time to tell you when you need to begin. For example, if you want to eat at 6 p.m., he/she might figure out: “30 minutes of prep + 45 minutes of cooking = 1 hour 15 minutes, so we should start at 4:45 p.m.” Then, when you put the dish in the oven, he/she could note the time, and say when it will be ready. Your child will be learning about elapsed time as well as helping you make dinner.
