

NEHS Service Hours Tracking Form



All National Elementary Honor Society Members are expected to participate in **6 hours** of service per semester for the community. **This is in addition to** the designated service projects of NEHS and SLCS grade level projects. Examples might include service projects of the parish such as “Share God’s Bounty”-helping box, organize, transfer, or deliver donations. Service projects of other organizations in which NEHS members participate, such as scouts or community groups can also be counted towards this requirement. Individual family and neighborhood projects are also accepted. Helping out at school programs such as open-house, working concessions or ticket taking at athletic events, or helping set-up in the gym for special programs are other ways to meet this requirement. Check with NEHS advisors for other ideas.

Members should complete the appropriate sections below and obtain the supervising adult’s signature verifying their participation. **Members are responsible for keeping track of their forms**, and documentation must be submitted to chapter advisors in May.
